STUDENTS MUST HAVE ALL OF ABOVE MATERIALS SUBMITTED TO APPLY**
- 4/15/09 Letters of recommendation should be requested by all recommenders.
- 5/15/09 Submit requests to Registrar's Office (20 Garden Street) to have transcripts sent to AMCAS. You may use the AMCAS-E Transcript Request Form available online. Ensure that Dennis has an up-to-date summer address, email, and telephone number before you leave town!
- Letters of recommendations should have begun arriving to Gregg Peeples' office (i.e., with Dennis) during the month of May
- 6/1/09** **ALL RECOMMENDATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED BY DENNIS**
Stamped envelopes (for non-participating Virtual Evals medical schools) should have been received by the Resident Dean's Office.
- 7/1/09** **AMCAS application should arrive in Resident Dean's Office (the earlier the better).**
- Non-resident tutors begin writing House letters *if all above-named materials have arrived.*
- 8/09-10/09 Completed Dean's letter can be sent electronically to participating Virtual Evals schools. Packets of hard-copy letters can be mailed to non-participating schools.
Materials to be sent to either electronically or via U.S. mail include:
- Letters of recommendation (indicated on Winthrop pre-med form)
 - House recommendation letter
- 8/09-9/09 Applicants begin filling in secondary applications. Ideally **all** secondaries should be submitted **no later** than the middle of September to ensure consideration by all medical schools.
- 11/09-3/10 Interviews at schools after secondaries have been received and applications are complete
- 3/30/10 Medical School are *required* to have extended acceptance notifications to students
- 5/15/10 Students must inform medical schools of their decisions to accept. Wait-lists officially open
